



Bake Sale Donations: Packaging Suggestions & Ideas

TIPS:

**Use disposable baking tins whenever possible to make your baked goods.*

**Package your baked goodies ready for gift giving. Remember, a lot of people are apt to purchase them for gifts or to bring to Holiday parties! Some packaging ideas are featured in pics below.*

**Big Lots and Dollar Tree are usually stocked with decorative tins (be sure to line with cellophane or wax paper), colored plastic wrap or Saran Wrap, gift bags, etc., for next to nothing!*

**Having samples for people to "try before they buy" will significantly boost sales for PPA !*

**Bake Sale Tags will be provided for you to fill out to list the recipe name on the front and the ingredients on the back. (Listing ingredients used in recipes is very important due to food allergies.)*

**Large quantities of ingredients can be bought much cheaper at Sam's Club or COSTCO.*

**Variety is they key to a successful bake sale, so now is your chance to get creative!!!*



Cookie Mix in a Jar is always a big hit!

Be sure to make a batch or two to hand out samples!

(For mix in a jar, simply layer dry ingredients attractively, then include the full recipe on a Decorative Holiday gift tag.)



Packaging your cookies or brownies in cellophane with a Holiday bow (in groups of 1/2 dozen and dozen) make them even more appealing!
